CALL FOR MANUSCRIPTS

The editorial team of the *Texas Journal of Literacy Education* invites you to submit your literacy research and/or effective and innovative teaching strategies to the next issue. We welcome all voices from literacy researchers, classroom teachers, and graduate students. The last volume's acceptance rate was approximately 50%. The blind review and editorial decision process typically takes about 6-8 weeks. The deadline to be considered for the second issue of volume four is October 1, 2016.

PREPARING YOUR MANUSCRIPT

Please prepare two files: a blinded manuscript and a cover letter. Blinded manuscripts must:

- include the title of the work;
- follow APA (6th edition) formatting guidelines;
- between 2,000 and 6,000 words, not including references;
- include an abstract of 250 words or less (research submissions only);
- have all references to author(s) removed for blind review;
- tables and figures should be embedded in the manuscript and figures.

Cover letter should include:

- the title of your submission;
- your name and affiliation (as you would have them published) and your email;
- addresses and any coauthors should be listed in preferred order, with name, affiliation, and contact information.

SUBMIT YOUR MANUSCRIPT
